- 1. Incur all costs required for compliance with the applicable regulations,
- 2. Be subject to DHCD monitoring for compliance, and
- 3. Accept any applicable penalties for noncompliance.

The undersigned acknowledges that this certification will be relied upon by DHCD in its review and approval of proposal for funding, and any misrepresentation of information or failure to comply with any conditions proposed in this certification could result in penalties, including the disbarment of Applicant for a period of time from participation in DHCD administered programs.
