## ORDER SCHEDULING TELEPHONIC HEARING<sup>1</sup>

On February 1, 2021, Respondent answered the Notice of Infraction with a plea of Deny. Therefore, the parties are **ORDERED** to participate in a telephonic evidentiary hearing before an Office of Administrative Hearings Administrative Law Judge on <u>March 1, 2021</u> at 1:00 p.m. To participate in the hearing, you and any witnesses must call 1-202-860-2110 (you must first dial the "1") and when prompted, enter Meeting Access Code 123 456 789. When you are asked for a participant identification number, simply press #.

The parties are REQUIRED to confer to determine whether they can settle this matter without a hearing or resolve any disputed issues. At least seven (7) days before the hearing, the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs shall submit a statement certifying that the parties have conferred and advising the court whether the parties have settled.

If a hearing is no longer necessary, a motion to dismiss may be filed instead of the statement certifying that the parties have conferred. In addition, the parties shall discuss any exhibits, witnesses, and stipulations of fact they propose. Even if the parties cannot resolve the
